Class Fees: \$15.00 per class, \$10 for youth

Entries Due: May 1, 2023

Late Fees: \$20 per class, \$15 for youth (Cutoff date for late entries is May 15)

CLASSES

NMDA classes will be offered for Miniature Donkey Youth, Pre-Green, Green, Open, Non-Driving and Teams, Halter, In-hand and Driving.

ACOSA classes for all breeds of long-ears

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Champion and Reserve Champion High Point in each division,
Champion Halter Miniature Donkeys, Junior Champion, and Best of Breed,
Awards for ACOSA Champion (must be registered with ACOSA prior to the show), (all longears are invited!)

Ribbons will be given for 1-5th place

Entry Postmarked on or Before: May 1, 2023

NMDA Fee: \$2.00 per donkey (must be registered with NMDA prior to show)

Flat Fee for Stalls: \$ 50 / stall

Bedding: Shavings **MUST** be purchased from the Expo Center. Cost is \$8.00 per bag. Minimum of one bag per stall. No outside shavings allowed (per the Expo Center).

RV Sites: If you need a RV site go to the Expo Office upon arrival. They do have workers on all shifts. RV sites are \$25.00 per night (\$26 if pay with credit card). The Expo Center RV Park is equipped with 366 50-amp full hook ups and four comfort stations containing showers, washers,

dryers and restrooms. They also have 133 additional 50-amp spaces and 296 additional 30-amp spaces with water and electric only. Reservations are not required, but there is a rodeo in town this weekend. Phone for the Expo Center is 405-275-7020

Hotel Note – There are LOTS of event in and around Shawnee this weekend. Hotel rooms will be in the \$300 range if you don't get one in the blocks ASAP. You are encouraged to go ahead and reserve a room. You can always cancel it later if your plans change.

Entrance to Expo Center: Parking is free. The entrance to the barns is off of Highway 177. There are several barns, there will be signs directing you to the appropriate building. The show arena and stalls will be located in Humphry Arena on the south west corner of the fairgrounds.

Arrival: Friday June 2-3, and departure is at exhibitors' preference on 4th or 5th. (Additional cost if you need to move in before June 3 or stay later than 5th).

Facility: Arena will be available only for animals registered in the show. No Exceptions. Stall buddies must also have the required health papers.

Show will start at 8:00 a.m. June 3th, Saturday morning, and 8:00 a.m. June 4th Sunday morning. (Subject to change depending on total entries, but not earlier than 8:00 a.m. Show manager reserves the right to change order of classes if necessary.)

Health: Proof of negative Coggins must be presented upon arrival. Must be an original Coggins – no copies will be accepted. Coggins must be dated within 12 months of June 6, 2022. Out of state animals must have a Health Certificate dated within 30 days of June 6, 2023.

Class Additions and Changes: All entries must be in by **May 1, 2023** (Late fees apply after that but must be received before May 15, 2023). Class changes or new entries will not be made at the show.

Late Entries: \$20/class adults, \$15/class youth

Rules: NMDA Rule Book 2011 Revised Edition

Measure: Height verification for the NMDA show will be done upon check in.

Timer: Electronic timer will be used for timed events

Ties: In the case of a High Point tie. The tie breaker will be number of blue ribbons, then highest placing for In- Hand Trail. For teams, the tie breaker will be number of blue ribbons, then Pleasure Driving.

Refund Policy: No refunds

Awards: Ribbons First – Fifth Place

High Point Awards: Champion and Reserve for Youth, Teams, Pre-Green, Green, Open, and Non-Driving

High Point Classes: Pre-Green, Green, Open and Non-Driving must show in respective halter class for donkey in that division.

Youth: 39, 57, 60, 63, 73 (High Point Youth will only be calculated with the youth designated classes. Points are given to the “youth”, not the donkeys. Youth showing in Pre-green, Green, Open, Non-driving or Teams will not be calculated into the youth High Point per NMDA rules)

Teams: classes 52, 53, 54, 55, 56

Pre-green: classes (respective halter class) plus **40, 58, 61, 64, 71**

Green: classes (respective halter class) plus **42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 65, 68**

Open: classes (respective Halter Class) plus **47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 67, 70**

Non-Driving: Classes (respective halter class) plus **41, 59, 62, 66, 69, 72**

Ties: In the case of a High Point tie. The tie breaker will be the number of blue ribbons, then highest placing for In-Hand Trail
