NMDA Fee: \$2.00 per donkey (must be registered with NMDA prior to show)

Stall Fee: \$ 15.00 per stall per night

Bedding: One bag of shavings will be supplied for free with each stall purchase. Additional shavings MUST be purchased from the Expo Center. Cost is \$6.00 per bag.

RV Sites: If you need a RV site go to the Expo Office upon arrival. They do have workers on all shifts. RV sites are \$25.00 per night. The Expo Center RV Park is equipped with 366 50-amp full hook ups and four comfort stations containing showers, washers, dryers and restrooms. They also have 133 additional 50-amp spaces and 296 additional 30-amp spaces with water and electric only. Reservations are not required.

Hotel Block: A block of rooms is available at the Comfort Inn and Suites for \$89/night for a king or two queens. You must contact the hotel directly to get this price (not on-line or via an 800-number). The phone number to the hotel is 405-273-8667. Includes hot breakfast, indoor pool. No pets. 5400 Enterprise Court, Shawnee, OK, 74804, US. It is right off of I-40, near the Shawnee Mall, Walmart and several places to eat. (There is a LaQuinta next door that does allow pets.)

Entrance to Expo Center: Parking is free. The entrance to the barns if off of Highway 177. There are several barns, there will be signs directing you to the appropriate building. The show arena and stalls will be located in Humphry Arena on the south west corner of the fairgrounds. Arrival: Friday June 4 or 5, and departure is at exhibitors' preference on 5, 6, or 7th. (Additional cost if you need to move in before June 4).

Facility: Arena will be available only for animals registered in the show. No Exceptions. Stall buddies must also have the required health papers.

Schooling Show will start at 8:00 a.m. June 5th, Saturday, morning. NMDA show will follow immediately after (approximately 2:30 pm).

Health: Proof of negative Coggins must be presented upon arrival. Must be an original Coggins – no copies will be accepted. Coggins must be dated within 12 months of June 7, 2020. Out of state animals must have a Health Certificate dated within 30 days of June 7, 2021.

Class Additions and Changes: Can be made until 5:00 pm the night before the class you want to change starts for a \$5.00 charge. (i.e. if you are showing in a class that shows on Saturday 5th, you may make the change before 5:00 pm on Friday the 4th; If you are changing a class on Sunday the 6th, you must make that change before 5:00 on Saturday the 5th)

Late Entries: \$20/class adults, \$15/class youth Rules: NMDA Rule Book 2011 Revised Edition

Measure: Height verification for the NMDA show will be done upon check in.

Timer: Electronic timer will be used for timed events

Ties: In the case of a High Point tie. The tie breaker will be number of blue ribbons, then highest placing for In- Hand Trail. For teams, the tie breaker will be number of blue ribbons, then Pleasure Driving.

Refund Policy: No refunds

Schooling Show: Beginning at 8:00 a.m. June 5th, there will be a "Schooling Show". Classes will include Halter, Showmanship, In-Hand Trail and Pleasure Driving. If time allows there will be other demonstrations and Q & A. The Schooling Show is being sponsored by AssN9 Ranch. There is no cost to attend if you are entered in the NMDA show. Cost for the Schooling Show alone is \$25 per person.
